## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All animals must be delivered between 10:00am & 7:00pm Tuesday.
2. All animals shall be individually inspected by a superintendent or assistant prior to unloading and tagging.
3. Each exhibitor must comply with the general eligibility rules of the fair.
4. The Swine Show will be judged strictly a market show.
5. All swine must have a health certificate (issued in exhibitor's name) showing the animal to be negative to an official test for pseudorabies conducted within 90 days prior to the exhibition; or that the swine came directly from a qualified pseudorabies negative herd, and the qualified pseudorabies negative herd number and dates of last qualification test are shown on health paper. Swine from pseudorabies quarantined herds **ARE NOT ALLOWED** to exhibit regardless of whether or not the show is terminal or non-terminal.
6. Market hogs may be crossbreds, purebreds, grades or hybrids.
7. Each exhibitor is limited to a maximum of 2 pigs to be penned in the swine barn.
8. A pair of market swine consists of any combination of barrows or gilts.
9. Weight classes for single market hogs & pairs will be assigned by the Superintendent. The Superintendent reserves the right to adjust weight groupings & number of classes to provide competition & even groupings for weight & numbers.
10. Each exhibitor is limited to a double entry in the single market class and a single entry in the pair class.
11. The first place market barrow, market gilt and market pair in each weight shall drive for champion of their lot.
12. Champion Barrow & Champion Gilt will drive for Grand Champion Market Hog.
13. Only wood shavings will be allowed for bedding. Use of oil or dressing on hogs will NOT be allowed.

### Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to anyone exhibiting swine at the McHenry County Fair
2. Swine entered in the contest must be owned by the entrant
3. Entries must be received and fees paid at the weigh in area Tuesday
4. Placing will be determined by the University of Illinois Carcass Program
5. Results will be announced Friday at the conclusion of the Open Show
6. Minimum weight required is 230 pounds

### PREMIUMS will be paid as a percentage of the entry fees as listed below:

First-40%; Second-20%; Third-15%; Fourth-10%; Fifth-5%, Sixth-5%, Seventh-5%
