**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Home Arts General Rules apply.
2. Bring entries to Building "F" on Tuesday, between 3:30pm and 7:00pm., or from 8:30am to 11:00am on Wednesday, August 5. No entries accepted outside of these times.
3. All food products must be removed Sunday evening as stated in Home Economic General Rules & Regulations. Any and/or all exhibits not retrieved in the time allotted will be disposed of. (This includes jars, and decorated cakes.) NO Exceptions!
4. Food products (excluding decorated cakes, and jars) must be exhibited on a **7" white Styrofoam plate inside a Clear Plastic Zip-lock bag**. No twisters or rubber bands.
  - a. Decorated cakes are to be displayed on an appropriate board.
  - b. Preservations must be sealed without paraffin and in a standard canning jar processed in a hot water bath. A second jar to replace the jar opened during judging can be brought to be displayed.
5. Commercial mixes allowed only if used as an ingredient in your recipe.
6. **Important:** An exhibitor may enter ONLY 3 items in any class as long as 1) they pay the class entry fee for each entry and (2) they use recipes for non-similar types of products for each class.
7. Food entries NOT made by the exhibitor WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. Any two exhibits that match by two different exhibitors will be disqualified.
8. Due to health hazards, no food will be returned.
9. All items will be exhibited.

First-\$5; Second-\$4; Third-\$3; Fourth, Fifth & Sixth -- ribbons only

**Amounts to be displayed:**

**Entries not following these guidelines WILL be disqualified.**

- Bread: 3" piece including one end of loaf
- Dinner Rolls: 3
- Biscuits: 3
- Muffins: 3
- Sweet Rolls: 3
- Coffee Cake: 1/4 of ring or 4"x4" end included
- Quick Breads: 1/4 of ring or 4"x4" end included
- Layer-type Cake: 1/4 of one 8" or 9" round layer, without frosting
- Angel or Bundt Cake: 1/4 of tube cake, without frosting
- Any Other Cake: 4"x4" piece or equivalent, without frosting
- Candies / Confections: 3 pieces, uniform size
- Cookies: 3, uniform size
- Donuts: 3, uniform size
- Bagels: 2, uniform size
- Cookies: Rolled & Rolling Pin / cutout; Drop / from spoon; Pressed / cookie press (spritz); Molded / hand formed
- Pies: 1/6 of 9" pie (No Dairy Products)
- Dehydrated food: Appropriate size canning jar with lid & ring for resealing (NO plastic bags), labeled with contents on top
- Preservations: One jar with lid, include ring for resealing. Must be labeled with contents on top.
- Honey: No entry shall have any label except lot 7. Lot 7 may have a label, but the label shall have no printing or marking that could identify the exhibitor or apiary.

- LOT 1 Light extracted strained honey in clear Queenline jar (3 1-lb jars)
- 2 Amber extracted strained honey in clear Queenline jar (3 1-lb jars)
- 3 Dark extracted strained honey in clear Queenline jar (3 1-lb jars)
- 4 Display of cut-comb honey in 4 1/8" x 4 1/8" x 1 3/8" deep clear plastic boxes (inside measurement) – 3 boxes
- 5 Light, chunk honey in round glass jar (3 1-lb jars)
- 6 Frame of Honey, 5 1/4" or 6 1/4", for extracting or cut comb
- 7 Comb honey in round section (Ross rounds) with clear covers on at least one side (3 sections)
- 8 Beeswax, molded in commercial forms for sale, not less than 3 lbs
