### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All RULES AND REGULATIONS: Junior and Open Shows apply.
2. Check-in between 1pm and 8pm on Tuesday. **Health papers are required at unload.** Livestock health regulations will be adhered to. If there is any problem regarding their ruling, a veterinarian will be called at the exhibitor's expense.
3. There will not be a pen charge, if you are also entered in open class. If you are not entered in Open Show Dairy Goats, there is a pen charge of \$3.00 per pen.
4. Only American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA), American Goat Society (AGS) and Canadian Goat Society (CGS) registered, recorded or applied for animals that are recognized by ADGA as dairy animals may be shown in official American Dairy Goat Association shows.
5. All animals shown must be in the name of the exhibitor. No Farm names.
6. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older. The original registration or stamped duplicate by ADGA is required for all animals under 6 months of age.
7. Animals with natural horns will not be shown. No paper bedding allowed.
8. All animals must be entered in their age lot in order to be shown in group lots.
9. There will be a 10:00pm Wednesday, August 5 milk out under the supervision of the show committee.

### PREMIUMS will be paid as follows: (all lots except champions)

First-\$15; Second-\$12; Third-\$10; Fourth-\$8; Fifth-\$6
