## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Home Arts General Rules apply.
2. Bring entries to Building "F" on **Monday**, August 3, between 12:00 noon and 7:00pm.
3. Each entry must be on a hanger. Quilters, call a Superintendent if you have any questions about display.
4. Exhibits must be the sole creation of the exhibitor unless otherwise stated.
5. Garments must be **NEW** or **LIKE NEW**, not noticeably worn. All entries must be clean. Soiled, stained or worn items will be disqualified prior to judging.
6. Last years 4-H McHenry County Fair entries may be exhibited.
7. No kits allowed.
8. Home sewing machines are to be used.
9. All identifying labels must be covered.
10. First place entries are automatically eligible for BEST of SHOW.

 Fifth & Sixth -- ribbons only.

<b>5</b>	Garment (all or partially quilted)
<b>6</b>	Tied Quilt (crib or larger+)
<b>7</b>	Quilted household accessory (pillow, runner, etc)

<b>CLASS D: CLOTHING (Age 14-19)</b>	
<b>LOT 1</b>	Skirt
<b>2</b>	Jacket
<b>3</b>	Blouse or top
<b>4</b>	T-shirt or sweatshirt

<b>6</b>	Dress
<b>7</b>	Party Dress (formal or semi-formal)
<b>8</b>	Slack, short or divided skirt

<b>10</b>	2 or 3 piece ensemble (must be articles of clothing)
<b>11</b>	Vest
<b>12</b>	Night wear

<b>4</b>	Pieced Quilt (any size)
<b>5</b>	Garment (all or partially quilted)
<b>6</b>	Tied Quilt (any size)
<b>7</b>	Group Quilt** (any size)
<b>8</b>	Quilted household accessory (pillow, runner, etc)

\* A Group Quilt is any quilt made by two or more people.

\*\* Creative Clothing includes NO PURCHASED CLOTHING. You may use appliqué, paint, embellishments of all kind, fabric manipulation, etc. to enhance the item you have made
